- Aligning risk assessments with TCFD, GRI, IFRS S1 & S2, covering policy, climate risks, and opportunities.

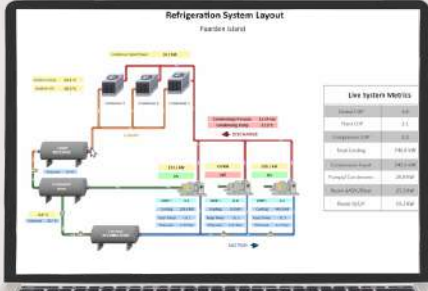
**Outcome:** A structured ESG roadmap that integrates sustainability into CCH's operations, drives cost savings and strengthens long-term resilience.
